Entry Rules for 2022 CIDS Regional Daylily Photo Contest

Subject matter of all photos must clearly be daylilies. If a photo is submitted that appears to ignore or skirt this requirement, the judges can refuse to consider it and it will not be displayed.

- 1 Two entries allowed per category; maximum of 10 entries per entrant.
- 2 Images must be from July 15th, 2019 to entry deadline.
- 3 Images must be taken by the person entering them
- 4 Entries will be emailed to ed siems@yahoo.com
- 5 Entry deadline March 15th, 2022, (the earlier you submissions arrive, the better)
- 6 Files can be a first generation jpeg, png or tiff.
- Files will be printed at 8" x 10" (landscape or portrait format). Please submit images at this size. The judges will not reformat an image, and one not meeting this standard can be eliminated from the contest.
- 8 Label each file with photographer, title and category.

Categories:

- a. Single daylily flower
- b. Daylily clump
- c. Named daylily variety
- d. Daylily seedling (single to clump)
- e. Garden scene in which daylilies are primary subject matter

- 9 Images will be judged by qualified photographers not affiliated with the daylily community
- There will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 3 honorable mention awards
- 11 The top 6 images in each class will be printed and displayed
- 12 The convention participants will vote on a best of show
- 13 The images will be put in a slide show and projected continuously on Friday afternoon.
